Sequels 'n' froth will predominate through summer

If you aren't escaping on a vacation this summer (or even if you are), you can still escape to the movies. Summer time at the cinema has become froth and fantasy, time with a couple of dramas thrown in for good measure and a complement of sequels.

Opening the season is the movie which, by dint of ancestry, will lay claim to blockbuster status, "Return of the Jedi." This is the third chapter in the middle trilogy of George Lucas' nine-part adventure saga that began with "Star Wars" and continued with "The Empire Strikes Back."

The regulars are all back, as Luke Skywalker (Mark Hamill) and Princess Leia (Carrie Fisher) venture to the planet Tatooine to rescue Han Solo (Harrison Ford) from the deep-freeze. Sir Alec Guinness and Billy Dee Williams appear in reprise roles, and some new creature characters have been added to the already interesting galaxy of Chewbacca, Yoda, R2-D2 and C-3PO.

Steve Martin, still looking for that elusive hit after "Dead Men Don't Wear Plaid" and "Pennies from Heaven," will be on the screen in a cranial comedy, "The Man with Two Brains." Martin stars as a famous brain surgeon who invents a screw-top method of brain surgery.

Moore and Maud Adams star, (Sean Connery will return as Bond in a film scheduled for fall release.)

Still another kind of hero is coming to theaters Friday, June 17, when "Superman III" opens. Blending action, romance and comedy, the sequel again stars Christopher Reeve as the Man of Steel and Margot Kidder as newsboud Lois Lane. They are joined by the talents of Richard Pryor, Robert Vaughn and Annette O'Toole.

And still another sequel is on the way with the raunchy gang from Angel Beach High School in "Porky's II — The Next Day." The teens continue to tangle with school administrators, corrupt politicians and unscrupulous

MORE COMEDY IS in store when a ghetto kid (Eddie Murphy) and a wealthy executive (Dan Aykroyd) get together in "Trading Places." And in "Yellowbird," a crazy-quilt cast consisting of Graham Chapman, Eric Idle, Peter Boyle, John Cleese, Marty Feldman (in his last performance), Cheech and Chong, and James Mason launch a wild spoof of pirate movies.

The four segments of "Twilight Zone," a film that attracted attention because of a tragic helicopter accident while shooting, are still being kept under wraps, but they're likely to be strange tales, as inspired by Rod Serling's vintage television series.

Music lovers have at least one film to look forward to — "La Traviata." Franco Zeffirelli wrote, designed and directed what is promised to be a dazzling version of Verdi's opera with Teresa Stratas, Placido Domingo and Cornell MacNeil in leading roles.

Altogether, it's a diverse group of light entertainment with more to come in July and August including "Jaws 3-D," Natalie Wood's last picture, "Brainstorm," and the film that logmar Bergman said will be his last, "Fanny and Alexander."
