Tucker, who received 1,071 votes, first was elected in 1978 and served as board president during the 1981-82 school year. He was defeated in his bid for re-election in 1982.

Campion, a member of the Oakley Park PTA and the Walled Lake PTSA, netted 1,042 votes in her first election bid.

"It's an awful nice feeling." said Campion.
