Schools make the grade in recent millage votes

A record 95 percent of all renewal millage pro-posals that were on the ballot in school elections held throughout Michigan last week were approved. The State Board of Education reported. New millages and combined proposals, however, didn't do as well. State Superintendent of Public Instruction Phil-lip E. Runkel said voters approved 208 of the 218 renewal millage proposals they voted on in Mon-day's annual school elections, an all-time high per-centage.

any s annual school electrons, an archive man per-centage. "This is the highest approval rate for renewal millages in anyone's memory," Runkel said. "It demonstrates that voters in the vast majority of communities in Michigan overwhelmingly support their public schools.",

OVERALL, NEARLY two-thirds of all school-millage proposals on the June 13 ballot — re-newais, additional millage proposals and combined proposals, including both renewal and additional millage - received voter approval, Runkel said. Millage proposals, the number approved and de-leated and the approval rate were: • Renewals — 218 proposals, 208 approved, 95 percent.

percent. • Additional millages — 173 proposals, 47 passed, 27 percent — about the same as list year. • Combined — 32 proposals, 20 passed, 63 per-cent. Runkel said the approval rate for combined proposals was up significantly compared to the 1981-82 school year, when less than half of all such proposals received voter approval.
