

All-Area track team buoyed by veterans

Robert Hies (senior); three-year member of Rochester's varsity; best long jump in county, of 22.7, according to Rochester coach Hal Commerston; Greater Oakland Activities League (GOAL) champion in long jump and 100-meter dash; regional long jump and 100-meter dash champion; holds school long jump mark of 22.34; will attend Arizona State University to run track.

Chris Kramer (senior); four-year member of Athens High School varsity track team; reached peak of 14-feet even four times this spring in the pole vault; Athens' team captain; runs hurdles and 440; honor student; will attend Purdue University.

TRACK EVENTS

Pat Lareau (senior); four-year member of Troy's track team; second in Southeastern Michigan Association in high hurdles; third at regional and county meets in high hurdles; also ran low hurdles and sprint relays; has "impeccable" technique, according to coach Baneroff.

Glen Williams (senior); a three-year member of Southfield's track team; holds school record for most points in a season (202 1/2); owns school records in both hurdle events; regional and league champion in low hurdles; fourth at state meet in low hurdles; undefeated in dual meets in low hurdles; will attend Eastern Michigan University this fall.

Terrence Robinson (senior); Oakland County 100-meter champion for Southfield; Southeastern Michigan Association (SMA) 100-meter champion in record time of 10.9; undefeated in dual meets; third at regional in 100-meter; made it to 200-meter semifinals at state meet; one of Southfield's best sprinters ever, according to coach Eschman.

Hank Woodmore (senior); state 200-meter Class B champion for Avondale with a time of 22.48; sixth in long jump at state meet; double-winner (long jump and 200-meter) at county meet; North Oakland Activities Conference (NOAC) league champion; will attend Michigan Christian College this fall.

Jeff Zurgable (senior); regional, county and Greater Oakland Activities League (GOAL) champion for Rochester High School in 400-meter run; best 400-meter time this season was 49.7 at regional.

John McCleary (senior); four-year member of the Rice track team; state champion in 800-meter with the state's fastest time of 1:52.1; won regional with a time of 1:55.3; co-county champion; Catholic League champion in 800-meter and half-mile; thinking about attending the University of Michigan.

Mark Kring (junior); third at the state Class B meet in mile for Cranbrook; best time of 4:16.2 in mile; time of 1:58 was good for sixth place at state B meet in 800-meter run; third in 800-meter run at county meet; won North Oakland Activities Conference title.

Joe Davey (senior); four-year member of the Rice track team; won regional in 3,200-meter run with state's fastest time of 9:14.6; county mile champion; Catholic League two-mile champion; runner-up in 3,200-meter run at state meet; placed fifth in 5,000-meter run at Mansfield Relays; will attend the University of Tennessee.

Southfield (400-meter relay); Southeastern Michigan Association champion team; first at regional meet; second at county meet; best time of season was 43.3; won all races it wasn't disqualified in.

Rochester (800-meter relay); runner-up in Greater Oakland Activities League; regional champion team; third at Oakland County meet; 10th overall at state meet.

Rochester (1,600-meter relay); GOAL and regional champion team; best time of 3:21.3 at state meet;

Oakland county champion team; placed eighth at state meet.

COACH OF THE YEAR

Tom Eschman (Southfield) has 28-13 record in five years as Southfield coach; coached Southeastern Michigan Association (SMA) champion teams the past two springs; undefeated in dual meets in 1982 and 1983; only loss in 1981 was to Troy; was 5-12 in his first two years as boys' head coach; Southfield lost regional title this year to Rochester by one point; Southfield scored 17 points and took 13th place at the state meet — the school's best finish ever; "I have to credit the caliber of athlete I've had to work with as the reason for our success the past three seasons," Eschman said. "It took a while to change the attitude on this team . . . and it's been a very positive reaction."
