Continued from page 1 which have too often not protected the public, and which are badly in need of overhaul. "Because of the many technical problems encountered in this unusual case, it has been necessary for myself and for my staff to consult with the medical profession.

"Not only have physicians been generous with their time, but many of them have offered to come forth and testify against Dr. Clark because they realized he was a detriment to the medical profession and a danger to the public."

the cost of the Clark case yet has been made, but semi-official sources estimate it will turn out to be one of Oakland County's most expensive of recent years.

The change of venue itself, which shifted the trial site from Pontiac to Mason, added materially to the cost, and it was pointed out that fees of expert medical witnesses who were called to testify will add substantially to the amount.
