Glicks To Spend 4 Years In Brazil

Mr. and Mrs. John Glick and their children, Dena and Larry, of 30411 W. Twelve Mile, Farmington, will leave on Sept. 15 to become missionary houseparents in Maringa, Parana, Brazil.

The Farmington District Library has announced a revamped schedule of operation six days a week.

State Approves City, Twp. Bond Sales

The Michigan Municipal Finance Commission has approved three separate bond sales totaling \$625,000 for water and sewer improvements in the City of Farmington and Farmington Township.

The MFC approved \$15,000 of 1968 General Obligation Water Bonds and \$18,000 of 1968 Special Assessment Water Bonds for the city.

Proceeds from the bonds will be used to defray part of the cost of water main improvements in a Special Assessment District and are payable over 10 annual installments.

The general obligation bonds, amounting to \$15,000, will be payable from general taxes. The commission also approved sale of bonds totaling \$250,000 for water main improvements in three Special Assessment Districts in Farmington Township. These bonds are payable "primarily" from a like amount of special assessments due in 10 annual payments.

Also approved was the \$335,000 Grand River Crest Sewer Special Assessment Bonds to construct sewers in the township. These bonds are payable in 15 annual installments.

Announcement of approval was made by Attorney General Frank J. Kelley, chairman of the MFC. The commission also includes State Treasurer Allison Green and Dr. Ira Polley, superintendent of public instruction.
