I have been reading your column for a long time now and I was wondering what method you used to analyze a person's writing. Are there set rules in such an analysis?

There are two main schools of handwriting analysis. The trait analysts look at the shape of the individual letters, the other school looks at the overall or total picture of handwriting. I personally use both methods for an analysis. Everything a writer does on the sheet of paper has meaning for the analyst. Size, spacing, slant, margins, pressure, legibility, speed and simplification all contribute significantly to the analysis.
