FARMINGTON RESIDENTS were warned to drive with caution on Orchard Lake Road between 11 and 12 Mile roads because of construction work connected with a widening and resurfacing project. Residents were asked to use other routes whenever possible.

THE "COMPLETELY air conditioned" Clive Theater in downtown Farmington was showing "Abbott and Costello Go To Mars" and "Cry of the Hunted."

A CARTOON called "Ticklers" showed a woman reading a suggestion from a box while her boss looked on and fumed. "This suggestion might be for a company picnic," the woman said. "It says, 'Go jump in the lake!'"

A PACKAGE of 54 pull-out cotton swabs could be purchased for 89 cents at Smith Rexall Drugs, 27702 Eight Mile Road. The store called itself the headquarters for the "popular Ann De-lafield reducing plan for women."

AUGUST 8, 1963

A CRACKDOWN on speeders and

reckless drivers was urged by Farmington Mayor Robert Lindbert. At a city council meeting, the mayor said he was "deeply concerned with the amount of careless driving practices being reported in areas throughout the city." Councilmen Sandy Brotherton and Henry Forrest were reported to be in agreement with the mayor.

ST. FABIAN Elementary School, under construction behind the parish on 12 Mile Road, received an inspection from Father Frank Szanlawski. Cost of the school: \$1237,000.

THE OAKLAND County Road Commission erected new traffic signals and "no left turn" signs at Middlebelt and Grand River in Farmington Township.

THE DOWNTOWN Farmington Center Sidewalk Sale, held Aug. 2, "offered bargains, crazy bargains galore and several added features..." Many "red-haired young ladies shopping in the center" were given free cotton candy.

AUGUST 4, 1973

THE CITY OF Farmington Hills has offered facilities to establish the 47th District Court. Unless the city of Farmington, which shares the court, objects, plans will go forward for an addition to the present Hills Municipal Building to provide additional court rooms and space for court records.

HAGGERTY ROAD between Nine and 10 Mile roads, will be resurfaced this fall at an estimated cost of \$159,585.30.

THE ATTRACTION at the Farmington 4 Theater was "The Legend of Hell House." A Farmington Observer reporter described the picture, which starred Roddy McDowell and Paula Franklin, as "...satisfactorily bloodthirsty and ghoulish for the horror film genre."

CBC also aids people in choosing the nursing home that best fit the individual's needs, according to health problems and payment options. Although they can't suggest or promote a particular home, they do have state evaluation data available to the public.

The organization also suggests other options than nursing homes. Day care centers are less restrictive than nursing homes and are often preferred, Savonen said. If the person needs special

help there are specific programs offered. For example, if a person needs help cooking meals, there is a Meals on Wheels program available, and health care nurses who will visit the person and administer certain medications. In these cases, a nursing home wouldn't be the elderly person's only choice.

Persons wishing to seek aid from the CBC can call 476-2040.

The CBC office also keeps a list of the citations the state filed against each facility, and are available to the public by calling the CBC office.
