situations, but in other cases where immediate and extensive medical care is needed, as in a farm accident when a limb is cut off, the helicopter crew could be more effective.

"Less than 40 percent of the state has access to a paramedic team," she said. "We feel that if someone is trapped or in an area that doesn't have paramedics then we can go out and be of help."

"A lot of people might think we're trying to take patients away, but even though Survival Flight is based at U-M, the service is for all patients in the state," Lagreca said. "We'll take the patient to the nearest, most appropriate facility."

The total annual cost for operating the helicopter is estimated at \$900,000.

"Most of the trauma cases involve young people, and we believe by getting to those patients and giving care at the scene that they'll be better off," she said. "The money is worth it when you look at the effect it will have on lowering disability and mortality rates."

Survival Flight went on its first emergency mission May 16 and is averaging one flight a day. Most of the calls are from physicians in emergency rooms who want to quickly transfer a trauma patient to a hospital that is better equipped to administer to the person.
