Anna Ruth Jingoian, who will be remembered as "The Walking Lady of Farmington," died in St. Mary Hospital, Livonia, July 18 after a short illness.

"She never drove anywhere," said Nora Wait who mother who was known to walk for shopping in Livonia Mall or trips as far as away as Orchard Lake and 14 Mile Road from her home in downtown Farmington.

Many residents came to know who she was after several articles about her were written in the Farmington Observer. It was in keeping with her love of walking that she requested memorial gifts be sent to Crippled Children Society.

And many residents missed seeing her swift-paced stride in the past year.

"We had quite a few calls from people asking about her when they didn't see her out as much as she had been," said her daughter Nora Wait. "That was due mostly to her taking care of her mother and her husband, both at the same time."

Mrs. Jingoian was born July 15, 1915 in Reghi, Armenia.
