So many negative things have been said about nursing homes, something positive needs to be said about one that was run by a caring and thoughtful person who was devoted to the good care of the residents.
Whitehall Convalescent Home was run by such a person. The lady I am speaking about is Ruth Madigan, R.N. She is a credit to the nursing profession and has the quality of compassion for

people which is something you can't learn from all the textbooks in the world. If her residents had a problem, they felt free to talk to her about it. She talked to them on a one-to-one basis, not down to them. She spent her holidays with her "Whitehall family."
My father was a resident there for two and a half years. He couldn't have been in better hands. He was fed by the aides if he didn't feed himself;

his nails were clipped by aides when they needed it; when he had problems swallowing food, they poured it for him; when he choked on food, the aides used the Heimlich maneuver on him and saved his life. Some of these things may seem trivial to some people, and they could have been ignored as they are in some nursing homes, but at Whitehall they were done on a routine basis.
I wish to thank Ruth Madigan from

the bottom of my heart for the way she managed the home, along with the fine staff who worked with her for the good care of my father received while he was a resident at Whitehall.
I hope the Lord is as good to her as she has been to the residents at Whitehall.
