"There's been an order entered maintaining the status quo," Bibace confirmed, referring to the gym's construction.

Claiming that all parties involved in the legal battle remain friends, Soodgrass, the attorney who represents homeowners in the Holly Hills Farms subdivision, said "it's the principle of the thing."

The ruling is saying parochial schools can come in and purchase land anywhere they want and the zoning ordinances don't apply," Soodgrass said. "What if (Gibbert's opinion) says is that the private school gets preference. I happen to think the decision is very, very poor."

The city's zoning ordinances "have a very rational basis," Soodgrass said, indicating that the school

needs to be on a main road that can support the traffic and activity a high school attracts.

"Our research indicates that the zoning laws would have indeed applied to the Lutheran high school," Soodgrass said.

Although the Holly Hills Farms residents did not file a separate lawsuit, they did file a "friend of the court brief," the attorney said. "They (residents) are not a plaintiff or defendant... someone who has an interest in a particular lawsuit."

A basic conflict, Soodgrass said, is that "you can't shake the high school. You can't tell them not to use the school. The point is the school shouldn't be back there."

"If they (Lutheran association) lose this thing (in appeals court) they have other remedies," Soodgrass suggested, including selling the building or using it as an elementary school.

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
