

Search for missing woman extends to Oakland

A group of family members watched Harpe from the audience.

THE FAMILY expected at least 2,000 searchers to comb approximately 70 square miles in Macomb and Oakland counties. If enough people showed up, they hoped to broaden the area.

The search was to begin at 11 a.m. at St. Dorothy's Catholic Church in Warren, which is Bazzetta's parish.

Friends, relatives, and at least eight organizations including the Boy Scouts,

CB radio clubs and scores of interested people planned to take part in the search, Harpe said.

"With all the media coverage, it could be 300 or it could be 10,000 people who show up for the search," John Harpe, Betty's husband, said. "We haven't given up hope, and if nothing turns up that's hope in itself. The family has exhausted all our thoughts, and now we're looking for people to help us."

Betty said the family received a "tremendous response" from people in many communities. One man called

and said he would donate donuts for the search party, and McDonald's promised to provide coffee.

HARPE SAID she believes her sister was wearing a lime green golf dress with yellow flowers, because that's the only outfit that's missing from her closet.

John, Bazzetta's husband of two years, realized there was something wrong when he was unable to reach his wife by phone from St. Louis.

Bazzetta, who is 5-foot-6 and weighs about 150 pounds, returned home from St. Louis July 31 after spending three

weeks with her husband, who was on a business trip.

"Helen has been gone since Aug. 1, and everyday that goes by that we don't find her, makes it less encouraging," Harpe said.

The Warren Police Department encourages citizen participation and other police departments in locating Bazzetta.

"We have a specific jurisdiction, and we're talking about an endless area of where she could be," Warren Police

Sgt. Brian Black said. "I'm trying to look at the positive side, that she's alive, unharmed and that she'll call us."

The media coverage, and search efforts urged at least three people to call the Warren Police, Black said.

"From the calls we got, they said they saw a lady who looked similar, but all at different locations," Black said. "They said she was on foot, but when we showed them her photo, they weren't sure it was her."

The case will remain open until she is located, he said.
