

Nuclear war is insane, says Hiroshima visitor

What would happen if world leaders conducted nuclear disarmament talks in Hiroshima?

Surrounded by remnants of the bombing, now housed in Hiroshima's museum, they may reconsider further nuclear arms buildup.

That's the opinion of J.N. Shanberge, a Bloomfield Hills physician who recently visited Hiroshima and Nagasaki.

"If they would carry out arms negotiations at the museum in Hiroshima instead of fancy cities in Europe, there would be no question about the decision they would make," he said.

"They would completely outlaw nuclear armament."

"There would be no chance of survival in a bomb attack today. It's insane to even think of using them."

Shanberge, chief of the hemostasis and coagulation laboratories at William Beaumont Hospital, and Stanley Dienst, chief of the division of transplantation, department of surgery, at Henry Ford Hospital, discussed their visits at a meeting last week in Southfield.

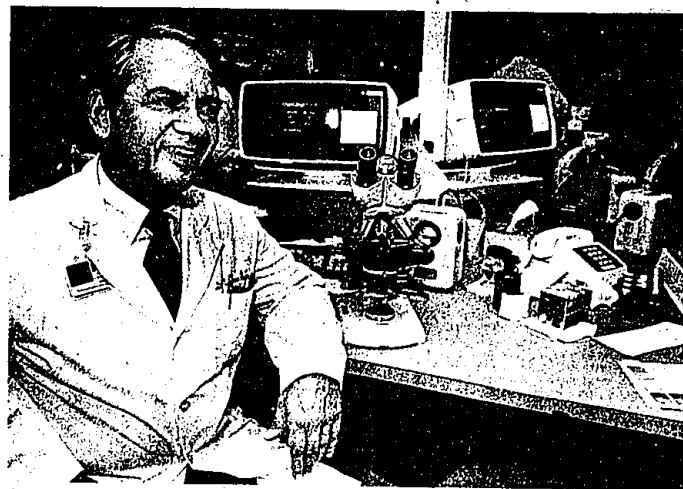
Responsibility, a nationwide nuclear disarmament group, and the Detroit Council for World Affairs, the forum drew more than 200 area residents. It was held to commemorate the 38th anniversary of the bombings.

SHANBERGE, who had been invited to Japan as one of the principal speakers for the Japanese Society of Blood Transfusion, joined Physicians for Social Responsibility shortly after his trip. Along with other doctors in the organization, he's committed to informing people about the medical consequences of nuclear war.

"I had no real interest in it before," Shanberge admitted. "The bombing of Hiroshima was rather abstract in my mind even though I lived through that period."

CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS REGULAR PUBLIC HEARING August 15, 1983

Mayor Hughes opened the public hearing meeting of the City Council of the City of Farmington Hills on August 15, 1983 at 7:30 P.M. Members present were: Barwell, Deane, Hughes, Williams and Wolf. Lauges and Socorro. Others present: City Clerk Cairns, Assistant City Manager Costello and City Attorney Poehlman. Council adopted a Resolution to request federal general revenue sharing. Council enacted Ordinance C-83 of the City Code to maintain compatibility of new single-family residential buildings with existing structures. Council approved reappointment of Frank Bair to the Economic Development Corporation for a six year term. An executive session was held immediately following the public hearing meeting to discuss pending litigation. Council adjourned at 8:30 P.M.
