Surplus cheese available

The Oakland Livingston Human Service Agency (OLHSA) will be distributing surplus commodity food to low income residents at St. Alexander's Church, 27835 Shiloh, '11 a.m. Tuesday, August 23.

Persons with households of one, two or three will receive one five pound brick of cheese and two one pound bricks of butter. Households of four or

more will receive two bricks of cheese and three bricks of butter.

Proof of residence will be required (driver's license, personal I.D. etc.), as well as proof of income (pay stub, unemployment card, food stamp card, etc.). Proof of household size must be presented such as birth certificates or medical cards. Without this verification an applicant will be treated as a household of one.

- Wednesday, Sept. 7 — Sixth-grade orientation (morning). All students report in afternoon.
- Thursday, Sept. 8 — students report all day.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

- Tuesday, Sept. 6 — students morning only.
- Wednesday, Sept. 7 — students all day.
