The twice-a-week sessions will meet Mondays and Wednesdays, beginning Monday, Sept. 19, 8:30-9:30 p.m., at the Piemonte Club, 34500 Nine Mile Road in Farmington Hills. Fee for the nine-week session is \$35.

**SENIOR ADULT WAYNE NEWTON SHOW** - Join the senior adults for a trip to Merrillville, Ind., Sunday and Monday, Oct. 16 and 17.
