

# Our neighbors gear up for fall festival

Last year it drew 50,000 people, but lost \$1,665.

This year, West Bloomfield's Fall Festival aims for an even bigger crowd — with a margin of profit.

Fireworks and the launching of hot air balloons highlight Friday's opening events at the 1983 West Bloomfield Fall Festival.

The third-annual community celebration, on the grounds of Henry Ford Hospital's West Bloomfield Center, Maple West of Drake, also will commemorate the township's 150th birthday.

Hours are 6-10 p.m. Friday, noon to 10 p.m. Saturday and 1-7 p.m. Sunday. Opening ceremonies will feature awards in the Sequential Essay Contest, presented by Manufacturers

National Bank of Detroit.

Some 19 entries were submitted on the subject "West Bloomfield: The Way We Will Be in 2033."

First-prize winner is Lisa Chatlin, a senior at West Bloomfield High School. Second prize will go to Robert Clauser Jr., also a West Bloomfield High School senior. Third place will be awarded to Brian Warchawsky, a 1983 West Bloomfield High School graduate.

The fireworks, balloons, sky divers, mock Civil War Battles and old-time craft demonstrations all are free. A \$1 donation per car for parking is asked.

A police dunk tank, with proceeds going to the Bruce Sharp Fund to help the 24-year-old West Bloomfield youngster get a new liver, will be ongoing all weekend.

The second-annual photo treasure hunt of West Bloomfield also will take place all weekend. The event, sponsored by the Concerned Citizens for West Bloomfield and the West Bloomfield Land Conservancy, will be featured in the merchants' tent. All are eligible to test their knowledge of the township.
