TAKE NOTICE, That the Michigan Department of Natural Resources proposes to hold a hearing to the Bloomfield Township Hall, 4250 Telegraph Road, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan, at 7:00 p.m., Tuesday, the 27th day of September 1983.

The purpose of the hearing is to secure the views of interested persons concerning the following application for permit:

Application for Permit (612-1431) under the Inland Lakes and Streams Act (1972 PA 348, as amended) by Mr. Ronald Zimmerman, 1734 Morningglow Way, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan 48302, to develop, construct steel substructure on pier, boat ramp, and fill on Upper Long Lake in Section 18, Bloomfield Township, Oakland County, Michigan.

The application may be reviewed in the Land Resources Programs Division Office, c/o Civil District 14, Office, 4555 West Wixom Lake Road, Pontiac, Michigan, during normal office hours.

The hearing will be held pursuant to Section (6) of the cited statute. The hearing will not be a court-like proceeding; witnesses will not be sworn, and there will be no cross-examination. Public hearings are primarily informational and are held to encourage the expression of views and presentation of facts.

The Michigan Department of Natural Resources will, upon written request, provide a copy of the hearing transcript and/or advise of the Department's decision on the application.
