Posture plays a large role in the creation of an individual's image, he said. Europeans are noted for their grace and confident posture. Americans, however, are more quickly identified by droopy shoulders, protruding stomachs and shuffling feet.

During a recent class in Royal Oak, McCue demonstrated what he called the "neutral stance" — head beld high, shoulders back, stomach in and looking relaxed and natural.

But he also tells students that expression requires the shaping not only of the physical self, but also the inner self.

"Eind your lanes acong and learn to

"Find your inner song and learn to sing it. Have specific images of what you want to become, what you want to achieve.

"As part of your daily exercise rou-tine, include actually reaching up for your dream. Believe it and it will hap-pen.

"Don't let time slip by you unnoticed and unused. Success is not an accident. It's hard work that pays off."

McCUE IS about 5 foot 10 and weighs 140 pounds. When he was younger he had a weight problem, but the extra poundage worked to his ad-

vantage. He managed to land a role as "the Buddha" in a stage play, a part that required him to wear a gold "diaper" and gold body pain.
"There I was on the stage, sitting on top of a 20-foot staircase with all my golden fat hanging out," he recalls, "making miracles with Oriental gestures. It was great."

Later, he learned of a musical which had a part for a slim and trim young man. He went on a crash diet, lost 30 pounds and got the part.

McCue also bas worked as an opera singer, actor and teacher. In his workshops, participants have included accountants, advertising executives, salespeople, students, clowns, nurses, authors, electricians, lawyers and one farmer.
