

Israeli educator to talk

Avi Kesse, Israeli education, sociologist and political activist, will speak at 8:30 p.m. Tuesday in Birmingham Temple, 28611 12 Mile. His talk is called "Struggle for a Democratic Israel."

Admission is free.

One of the founders of Mizrash, the School for Social Zionism, and of Kol Koreh, the Israeli counterpart to the American Israeli Civil Liberties Coalition, Kesse will address issues dealing with the Israeli economy, U.S.-Israeli relations and the current political situation. Kesse is the author of numerous articles on social and economic issues

and on Israel's foreign relations.

In an interview with Newsweek, Kesse expressed his fears about the direction in which Israeli society is headed.

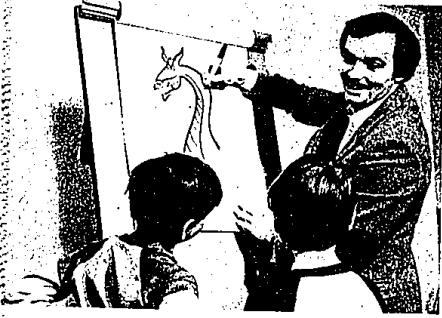
"The question is whether Israel will be the center of Jewish creativity or the center of Jewish problems. I fear the latter," said Kesse.

Kesse's trip is being sponsored by the American Israeli Civil Liberties Coalition, an organization of American Jews and friends of Israel that advocates the development of civil rights and civil liberties in the State of Israel.
