Alice Partiow Curtis, Michigan writter/pet photographer and comparell cat lover, makes the most of every feilnes's weakness—empty boxes.

The dismal aesthetics of a cardboard box permanently installed in the living room or family room turn some people off. And they never know the pleasure of watching their pet coxy up to the box, lunge at it, stalk it and eventually settle down inside in what seems to be a kind of serone security.

CURTIS TURNS box beautification into a catchy, step-by-step art form that culminates in a cat house to suit any architectual taste from simple cottage to castle.

If the cottage looks a mite plain and the castle too catenatious for Tabby, cat house builders have a choice of colonial, ranch or townhouse, with or without garage, porch, windowboxes and cornices.

Curtia's no-nonsense, easy to follow directions, accompanied by lots of photographs for how to do the project are deceptively simple. She's aiready de-


