Ford II will attend

Hospital unit is dedicated

Henry Ford II and son Edsel B. Ford II will be keynote speakers when Henry Ford Hospital dedicates its 78-acre West Bloomfield site at the Edsel B. Ford Center at 1 p.m. Friday.

Edsel B. Ford, only child of the hospital's founder and auto pioneer Henry Ford, was vice president of the HFH Board of Trustees from 1915 until his death in 1943.

The two facilities on the Edsel B. Ford site — the Henry Ford Hospital West Bloomfield Center and Maple Grove — will retain their individual names.

The center, which opened nearly eight years ago, is an outpatient facility. Maple Grove provides treatment for alcoholism and other chemical dependencies. It was added in 1981.

Friday's dedication will be on the east lawn of the site. It will move to the hospital's lobby if the weather is bad.

THE PROGRAM is scheduled to include:

- Welcome — Jane A. Muer of Birmingham, chairwoman of the HFH West Bloomfield Center Board of Trustees.

• Invocation — Rabbi Richard C. Herz, rabbi emeritus of Temple Beth El in Bloomfield Township.

• Introduction — Robert J. Vlasic of Bloomfield Hills, past chairman of the board of trustees.

• Recognition — Edsel B. Ford II, speaking of major supporters of the two West Bloomfield facilities.

• Dedication — Henry Ford II.

A RECEPTION and tour of the ambulatory surgery facility, 24-hour emergency room and some clinical areas are planned. On display for the event will be two cars: a 1940 Continental, which Edsel designed as his personal car, and a 1984 Mark VII.

The dedication of the West Bloomfield center continues a hospital tradition of honoring members of the Ford family and other supporters, according to a hospital spokeswoman.
