Tragedy Mars Mayor's Visit

The exchange of mayors between Farmington and North Muskegon was shortened by tragedy Monday.

The mayor's exchange, part of the Michigan Week celebra-

tion, ended at dinner time Monday when the visiting North Muskegon mayor and his wife were forced to return to their home by the death of her father.

North Muskegon Mayor William Andree and his wife Wilma were scheduled to end a day of community tours by attending the regular city council meeting Monday night.

While at dinner with civic leaders in the Botsford Inn, however, news came of the sudden death of Mrs. Andree's father.

Before the unexpected news, the couple toured city facilities, Orchard Ridge campus of Oakland Community College, LaSalle Winery and attended the formal dedication of the new Farmington Township offices.

While Farmington Mayor Wilbur Brotherton and his wife visited in North Muskegon, the Andrees were hosted by City Councilman John Allen.

Plans for the remainder of Michigan Week include a businessmen's luncheon at the Elks Club today on Our Livelihood Day. The Farmington Exchange Club is the host.

Education Day, Hospitality Day and Our Youth Day will finish Michigan Week for 1970.

Study In Germany




