Art show opens

Ross Arkell of Birmingham will exhibit his oil paintings at the ninth annual Birmingham Temple Art Show. Featuring works by more than 50 prominent artists, the show will be held Friday, Saturday and Sunday at the temple, 28611 West 12 Mile, Farmington Hills. New works in jewelry and weaving will be introduced in addition to the many selections which have been featured in the

show previously. Rag rugs, baskets, ceramics, calligraphy, photographs, sculpture and stained glass are among the items for sale. A wine and cheese preview is planned Friday. Admission is \$3. Hours are from 8-11 p.m. Friday; noon to 9 p.m. Saturday and noon to 5 p.m. Sunday. Admission to the show Saturday and Sunday is \$1. The exhibit is a fund-raiser for the temple.

Detroit Symphony kicks off anniversary

For the fifth year, the J.L. Hudson Company and the Detroit Symphony Orchestra will combine efforts to present a series of concerts in five suburban Detroit locations.

Scheduled to coincide with the orchestra's 70th anniversary celebration, the concerts will be held during the annual Hudson — DSO Metro Tour, Thursday, Nov. 17, through Wednesday, Nov. 23.

DSO Assistant Conductor Michael Krajewski will be on the podium for each concert.

Entitled "Music Fit for a King," the program will include Beethoven's "King Stephen" Overture, Handel-Hart's Suite from "Music for the Royal Fireworks," Bizet's "L'Arlesienne" Suite, Mussorgsky's "Procession of the Nobles" and Strauss' "Emperor Waltz." Also included are selections from Lerner and Loewe's "Camelot" and the Wedding March from Mend-

elssohn's "A Midsummer Night's Dream."

The first, sponsored by the Rochester Arts Commission, will be at 8 p.m. Thursday, Nov. 17, at Rochester High School, 180 South Livernola.

Pianist performs at St. Mary's College

Pianist Leszek Bartkiewicz will open the 1983-84 "Music at the Galeria" series at 5:30 p.m. Sunday, at St. Mary's College, Commerce and Orchard Lake roads, Orchard Lake.

Bartkiewicz came to the United States from Poland as a refugee in September, 1981.

In October, 1981, he had the opportunity to play for Mischa Kottler, formerly with the Detroit Symphony Or-

chestra and now head of the piano department at Wayne State University.

As a result of that meeting, he was given an audition and granted a tuition fellowship to the University of Michigan School of Music. The fellowship will enable him to work toward a doctoral degree in the performing arts.

During the past year, he won the University of Michigan Concerto Competition and the Grose Pointe Music Festival Competition.

Last year, he won the Irene Tintner Competition in Saginaw and the graduate fellowship competition at the University of Michigan School of Music.

A soloist in the Cracow Symphony Orchestra in Poland in 1981, Bartkiewicz also was winner of the following competitions: Tokyo Piano Competition in Japan and the Lugano International Piano Competition in Switzerland, 1980; Young Polish Pianist

Competition in Slupsk, Poland, and admitted to the second stage of the Bolzano Piano Competition in Switzerland, 1978; Chopin Society Competition Music Scholarship for four years of study at the Chopin Institute in Poland, 1978.

He attended the Frederick Chopin College and the Music Academy, both in Cracow, Poland. He also took master classes in Prague, Czechoslovakia and Antwerp, Belgium.
