Pianist performs at St. Mary's College

Planist Leszek Bartkiewicz will open the 1983-84 "Music at the Galeria" se-ries at 3:30 p.m. Sunday, at St. Mary's College, Commerce and Orchard Lake roads, Orchard Lake.

Bartkiewicz came to the United States from Poland as a refugee in Sep-tember, 1981.

In October, 1981, he had the opportu-itly to play for Mischa Kottler, for-nerly with the Detroit Symphony Or-

chestra and now head of the plano de-partment at Wayne State University.

As a result of that meeting, he was given an audition and granted a tuition fellowahly to the University of Michi-gan School of Music. The fellowship will enable him to work toward a doc-toral degree in the performing arts.

During the past year, he won the Uni-versity of Michigan Concern Competi-tion and the Grosse Pointe Music Festi-val Competition.

Last year, he won the Irene Tintner Competition in Saginaw and the gradu-ate fellowship competition at the Uni-versity of Michigan School of Music.

A soloist in the Cracow Symphony Orchestra in Poland in 1981, Bart-klewicz also was winner of the follow-ing competitions: Tokyo Plano Compe-tition in Japan and the Lugano Interna-tional Plano Competition in Switzer-land, 1980; Young Polish Planist

Competition in Slupsk, Poland, and admitted to the second stage of the Bolzano Piano Competition in Switzerland, 1978; Chopin Society Competition Music Scholarship for four years of study at the Chopin Institute in Poland, 1976.

He attended the Frederich Chopin College and the Music Academy, both in Cracow, Poland. He also took master classes in Prague, Czechoslovakia and Antwerp, Belgium.
