During the pherests procedure, blood is drawn from a donor and circulated through a machine to remove only a

certain component, either plasma, platelets or white cells. The remaining components are then returned back to the denor's blood stream. The procedure of the denor's blood stream. The procedure of the components of the components of the component necessary for clotting, are used to treat patients, with leakening and those undergoing chemotherapy for cancer. White cells are used in treating patients whose bodies are not producing enough of these cells needed to fight bacteria infections. Pheresis

also provides plasma which contains clotting and infection fighting factors required by shock and burn patients.

Shafer explained that pheresis is important because, utilize components obtained through processing whole blood donations from numerous, random donars.
