Folksingers' new tune

While business at the Chess Mate and the Retort soon fizzled, business at the Raven continued to boom, Coden said.

FOR MORE than 20 years, the Raven was the principal gathering place for the folk music crowd. It closed in 1980 because of financial difficulties. Since the Raven died, the Detroit area hasn't given birth to a new haven for folksingers.

Folktown in Southfield — which only runs a season each year — is fighting to keep the coffeehouse an integral part of the Detroit music scene.

"Detroit has jazz, country, blues — almost every sort of music except

folk," said Kenneth Knoppow, a Farmington Hills resident who started the Folktown series two years ago. An attorney, he runs the coffeehouse in his spare time with the help of Southfield's Cultural Arts Division and volunteers.

"Folk music doesn't have mass appeal. But a lot of people relate to the music once they're exposed to it."

Booking both local and out-of-town entertainers, Knoppow manages to draw a large enough crowd to keep the venture going.

But his dream is to expand the seasonal series to a year-round club.

"My goal is to recreate something like the Raven and make it economically viable," he said.

Nutcracker benefit set
