

Principal speaks out on Campus Life issue

Signs and posters bearing the Campus Life activities have been particularly annoying to those who want the group out of the schools.

"We have some students at North Farmington who have had some of their personal needs met by a group which happens to be called Campus

Life," Graham said. "It happens to be a Christian group."

"And they have found that they have enjoyed some of the activities. When those activities are going on, they get all pumped up about them and talk about them in the lunchroom or in the classrooms before the classes start."

"I think it's perfectly natural for youngsters to act like that. . . I don't

find it odd that when something like that is going on, somebody might put up a sign."

GRAHAM DREW a parallel between the Campus Life signs and discussion some students have about trips to Florida during the spring break.

"In another month, our seniors are going to be talking about the Florida

trips," he said. "We have an official board policy that says that the school district does not have senior trips and we cannot post advertisements and so forth."

"But there's going to be one heck of a lot of discussion about Florida: 'Where are you going to room?' and 'Who's going to furnish the alcohol?'"

"When kids are exuberant, I think

they're going to say and do things like that."

But Graham said that he's being very careful about the posters he's allowing to be put up on the bulletin boards and walls of his school these days.

"Two years ago, the Jewish Community Center had a marvelous program with slides about Israel today," he said. "We had a poster telling about it. Right

now, I don't think I'd put that poster up because of all the stuff that's going on around here."

Graham said he has discussed the Campus Life situation with Farmington Superintendent Lewis Schulman. The superintendent has promised to study the issue and make a recommendation to the school board in time for the Dec. 6 board meeting.
