Also, iron-rich foods should be cooked in small amounts of liquid so as to retain their iron content.

Large amounts of tea and milk should not be served with iron-rich meals as these products tend to inhibit the absorption of iron.

Lastly, if Iron supplementation is advised, it should be taken between meals for best absorption, unless it causes gastrointestinal distress.
