Extension specialists at Michigan State University suggest the items below would be welcome:

- Gift certificates from a local nur-
- sery or garden center, or from a seed, plant and gardening equipment catalog.

   A flowering plant to brighten the home during the holidays. Even if the plant is one that will be discarded after flowering, be sure to include care instructions with it.
- Flower or vegetable seeds. Someone who raved over some product of your garden will probably appreciate seeds of

- that variety to grow.

  Cuttings from a house plant or an IOU for cuttings from a shrub, a tree seedling or a transplant from your property at the appropriate time for planting.
- A coupon redeemable for some gamelening service or supplies. A horse owner might present a gardener friend with a coupon for a load of organic fertilizer, for instance.
- A tool or garden gadget rain gauge, for instance, or a large outdoor thermometer, a pair of sturdy gardening gloves, a roll of plastic mulch, peat pott or pellets and plastic flats for starting seeds even fluorescent tubes for a friend's indoor light garden.
