Hills officers walk a beat during holidays

"There is a personal pride in walking a beat, and they take pride in knowing they are curtailing crime activity by being there," Spencer said.

The first team was Sgt. Al Havner and Officer Brian DeGrande, who pounded the streets Nov. 28.

"The merchants were extremely receptive to the idea," Havner said. "You get to know the people that you're dealing with. Sometimes these people don't know how to contact you, because they aren't acquainted with you."

Foot patrol is good for public relations and an effective deterrent to shoplifting, he said.

Taking the walking patrol to the residential areas may be the next step, according to police Chief John Nichols. But, that hope is hinged on available manpower.

"Even though the area that will be covered is relatively small, the payback should be pretty big," Nichols said.

The foot patrol will not cost the city additional money, police officials said.

The department is taking officers that would be on a driving patrol and assigning them to walk a beat. Therefore, the patrol drivers have more area to cover in their districts, Spencer said.

THE EMPLOYEES working in Hunter's Square at 14 Mile and Orchard Lake feel an extra sense of security with the constantly visible presence of the men in blue. "I think this is a real good idea because the center has had quite a few incidents, and this should help by deter-

ring the criminal," Susan Breenick, manager of Tagg's, said.

Larry Gaynor, president of the Merchant's Association at the shopping area and owner of Gaynor's, said, "The police patrol should be a factor for those who aren't sure they want to do something. They'll think before doing it."

Communication between the police department and the merchants is one of the most important aspects of the program, according to Sgt. Peter Larion, who walked the beat Nov. 29.

"I WOULD simply ask that you instruct the planning commission . . . to determine what it is the city really wants to do," Smith said. "Do a study. Now the heat is off and you can do it with determination and consideration."

Smith told council members that they should realize Botsford is the third "special interest" to be granted an allowance under the height limit.

"The majority of the people in this city don't vote," she said. "The majority of people have not said yes or no to it (the height limit)."

But in 1979, voters defeated two ballot proposals, asking if senior citizen housing and industrial-research office buildings should extend beyond 50 feet.

Following the vote in favor of Botsford's plans, Dolan lauded Smith's sentiments that a study be completed on whether the city's height limit is necessary.

"This council has enacted height variations in special instances," Dolan said.

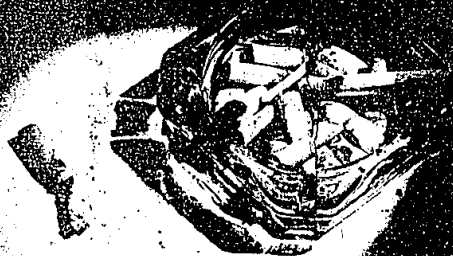
