DOWNHILL SKIING — Registration is being accepted at the Parks & Recreation office for all elementary, middle and high school students. The first-session teen ski bus is scheduled for Tuesdays, Jan. 3, 10 and 17 and the elementary bus is scheduled for Fridays, Jan. 6, 13 and 20. The ski buses will depart from various pick-up points at 4:30 p.m. and return approximately 10:15 p.m. The fee is \$35 per participant and includes tow ticket, lessons and transportation. Ski rental is additional. Register early, space is limited.

YOUTH SWIM LESSONS — Swim instruction will be offered for beginner through advanced skill levels on Saturdays, starting Jan. 7 through Feb. 25 at North Farmington High School. To take lessons, a child must be 38 inches at the chin. Advance registration is necessary in person or by mail at the Parks & Recreation office by Friday, Jan. 6.

FITNESS — Enjoy toning your body to formulated routines of exercises and dance. This activity will be taught by Norene Yuskowatz, a popular fitness instructor from our area. The twice-a-week sessions will meet 6:30-

7:30 p.m. Mondays and Wednesdays, beginning Jan. 9, at the Plemontese Club, 38500 Nine Mile, Farmington Hills. The fee for this nine-week session is \$35.

YOUTH BASKETBALL — Registration is still being accepted for this team sport at the Parks & Recreation office for the following divisions: boys 4th and 5th grades; 6th, 7th and 8th grades and girls 6th, 7th and 8th grades. Games will begin on Saturday, Jan. 7 for eight weeks. Registration fee is \$15 per person.

ICE SKATING LESSONS — Learn to skate or improve your skating techniques this coming winter. Our lessons include beginner to advanced and meet for 30 minutes once each week for five weeks. Registration should be made at the Parks & Recreation office by Dec. 30. Class fee is \$25 per person.

SENIOR ADULT FOOD CO-OP — You can, with little fuss, shop this convenient way and save money all at the same time. All that is required is an initial membership charge of \$1 and \$3 for the purchase of each bag. Co-op is offered on the second and fourth Wednesday of each month. Contents of the bag are determined by seasonal harvest.

THERAPEUTIC BOWLING LEAGUE — This popular program is scheduled to begin 4:30 p.m. Friday, Jan. 6 at Ark West Lanes for individuals ages 7 and up who are mild to moderately mentally or physically impaired. Participants will be competing in a 10-week session. There will be an end-of-the-season party. A \$12 registration fee includes bowling, shoes and surprises. Registration will be accepted at the Parks & Recreation office.
