Campaign Quarters Permit Issued

FARMINGTON

A temporary occupancy permit was granted at the last Farmington City Council meeting to allow Carl Pursell to establish campaign headquarters in the old National Bank of Detroit building at Farmington Rd. and Grand River.

Pursell is a Wayne County commissioner from Plymouth who is one of two announced Republicans challenging Sen. George Kuhn (R-West Bloomfield) in the August primary. The other is Al Smith from Northville.

The request was the first appeal to come before the council under the new Central Business District ordinance. Permission for temporary use was required because there is no off-street parking.

Pursell has promised to make minor repairs and clean up the inside of the building which has been vacant for several years except for a brief period when it was used as a warehouse.

CITY MANAGER John Dinan recommended the temporary occupancy permit because it will be vacated again either in August or November, depending upon Pursell's success in the primary.

The campaign headquarters will be used mostly at night, but there will be a few workers manning the office in daytime hours.
