Oliver C. Irish, aged 84 years, died at the Grace house here Sunday morning, at 8:30 after a long illness which culminated in a stroke on Wednesday from which he never rallied.

Mr. Irish was born August 26, 1840 in West Bloomfield township and was therefore one of the oldest if not the oldest native resident of Oakland county.

He lived on the farm in West Bloomfield township until 1912, when he retired and moved to Farmington.

Surviving are an aged sister, Mrs. Electa White of Southfield and three grandchildren, Lurene Irish, who lives in California; Gertrude Irish of Wyoming, and Mrs. Angie Grace of Farmington, with whom he made his home.

Funeral services were held at the Grace house Wednesday afternoon. Burial in the North Farmington cemetery.
