THE FLOWERS are tubular in form with two up-turned lobes and three lower lobes. The throat of the flower is marked with a golden orange network that makes the flower especially attractive when it is closely observed. The flowers, which are attached in pairs, are small, but are so profusely produced that the shrub is literally covered with bloom in June.

The small, pointed leaves are pleasant but undistinguished. During the winter months the shrub is of interest because the bark on the trunks flakes off in large shredded pieces.

After the shrub has finished blooming is the best time to prune it. Each year some of the old wood should be removed and the shrub trimmed and shaped. Other than this, no care is required.
