Historical Diamond
The Great Mogul diamond was a celebrated. Eddlan diamond whose history is said to date from 56 B. C. In the Pourteeth century it fell into the hands of the rajsh of Malwa and later became the property of the Mogul emperors at Delhi. The French Jeweler, Taverpiler, sirs he saw the diamond at the court of Aurungzebe in 1605, and declared that it weighed, in the rought state, 703% carats. It is generally described, however, as a round, white rose-cut stone of 280 carats. It was probably stolen and broken up at the sack of Delhi by Nadir Shah in 1730. By some authorities it is identified with the Kohl-aur and by others with the Orlot.


