

Auction Produces \$275,000

The Channel 56 on-air auction was financially the biggest ever achieved by a public television station operated on the UHF band, it was announced by Channel 56 general manager James Christenson.

Bids totaled \$275,000 in the 70-hour sell-off of some 4,200 items of donated goods and services.

The Channel 56 total exceeded that of numerous public television stations, Channel 26, Los Angeles, which just completed a \$225,000 auction.

first auction and raised nearly \$50,000 in four days. THE AUCTION money will supply about a third of the cash needs of the community-owned station during the next 12 months. Channel 56 depends heavily on support from individual viewers who can become "members" with a contribution of \$15 or more a year.

"I call the auction proceeds 'growth dollars,' that will allow Channel 56 to substantially increase its service to the Detroit area community," Christenson said.
