Kadish thought a moment and then answered:

First, he's a supporter of Richard Nixon

Third, he's against a gradu-ated income tax. I'm for it." Kadish paused, then added: "There may be other differ-ences. Timestill tell."

WHAT KINDS of questions do people ask him?
I go through the issues, and then they ask me for my reasons for certain stands...I'm against parochiaid. I'm for tax reforms for school financing.

Kadish lately has been sock-ing Kuhn's procedural vote against abortion reform legis-tation. Is abortion really an issue that moves a lot of peo-ple?

"Yes, more than just a few women." Kadish answered. I'm sure a majority in the state is for some kind of re-form.

'I'm pot for repeal. I'd want some kind of limitations. I wouldn't want to see Michigan become an abortion mill.

"Id like to see a residency-requirement and a three-month limitation" on the point at which an abortion could be performed.
