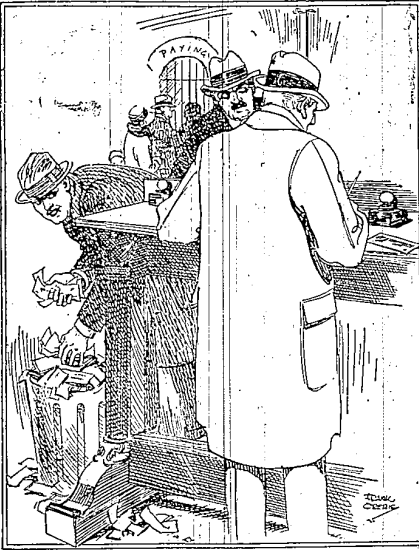

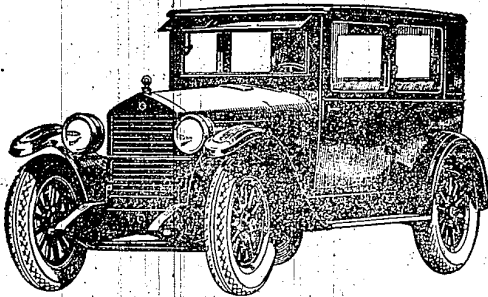

To the Editor:

When those who strive to secure legislation compelling the observance of Sunday, offer to insert an exemption clause for those who observe another day, they wonder why this class still oppose such legislation. In fact, they seem to be amazed at times at such an attitude.

If a law is just, it needs no exemption. There is no exemption from a just law. No one who believes in the golden rule will consent to put upon others what he would not have put upon himself. So in Sunday legislation, the thing to do is to go to the root of the matter, and deny the right and propriety of such legislation.

If the right of such legislation is once admitted, then the right is conceded for the majority to rule and to say that a certain day is the Sabbath an should be kept. It is easy to see, if this is granted, that the same majority can say that another day shall not be kept. Then, if the majority changes, this

majority may compel the observance of another day, and forbid the keeping of the day formerly enjoyed. The keeping of the Sabbath is too sacred a matter to be made the football of majorities. The conscience, educated by the Word of God, is the guide.

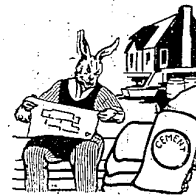
