

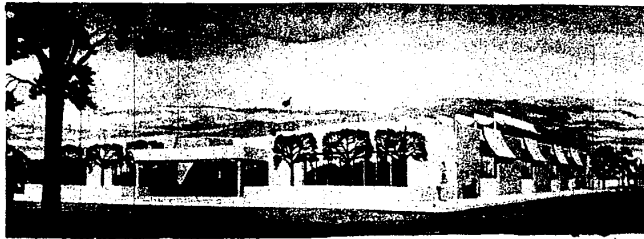
### Lady With Car Trouble Thanks All Who Helped

## Stromback To Head New Burroughs Unit

DuRay E. Stromback, former engineering manager and plant manager of Burroughs Corp.'s Plymouth plant, has been named vice president and group executive of a new group established by the firm.

He has been part of the present Business Machines Group for the last three years.

In making the announcement, Ray W. Macdonald, Burroughs president said.

The corporation announced formation of a Systems Manufacturing and Engineering Group to facilitate development and manufacture of its business machines and commercial data processing systems.

The group operates nine plants in the U.S. and employs 13,000 persons. One of its plants is located at 41100 Plymouth Rd.

## 1,400 Boys To Camp At Two Scout Sites

The biggest camping season ever is under way in Clinton Valley Council, Boy Scouts of America, with more than 1,400 boys expected to take part before the summer is over.

The four-week program designed to make summer camping available June 21-July 18 to those who normally would not have access to it.

Seven one-week camping periods will be held at the two council camps. The season opened Saturday, June 20, at Lost Lake Scout Reservation near Clare and the next day at Camp Agawam on Tommy's Lake near Lake Orion.

A FULL PROGRAM is available at each camp, including swimming and boating, advancement, nature and scouting skills.

The 115-acre Camp Agawam, one of the oldest Scout camps in Michigan, is used by the council on a year-round basis. The new 2,200-acre Lost Lake Reservation will be in its fourth year of wilderness camping.

Willard H. Wells, the council's director of supporting services, heads the program at Camp Agawam. Robert Rowley is director of Lost Lake activities.

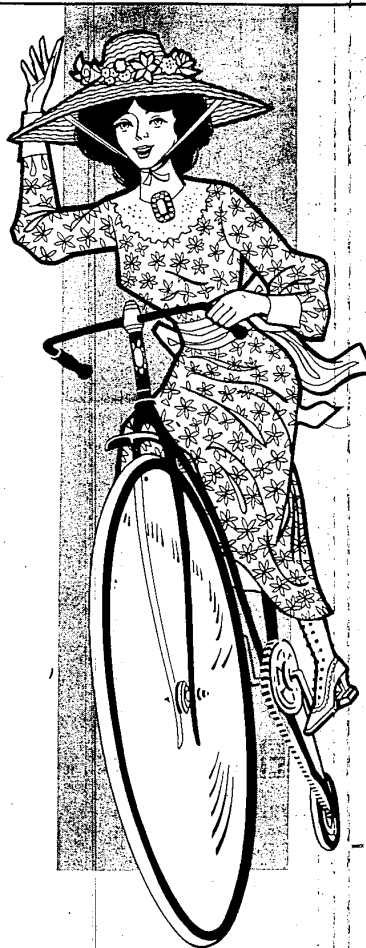
