Copeland, are living or dead, or whether or not any of the unknown heirs, devisees, legatees and assigns or any of the above named defendants, or any of them, are dead, or if living, where they may reside, or if dead, who or where their respective heirs, devisees, legatees or assigns may be or reside, although diligent search and inquiry with particular reference thereto, plaintiffs have been unable to ascertain the same. 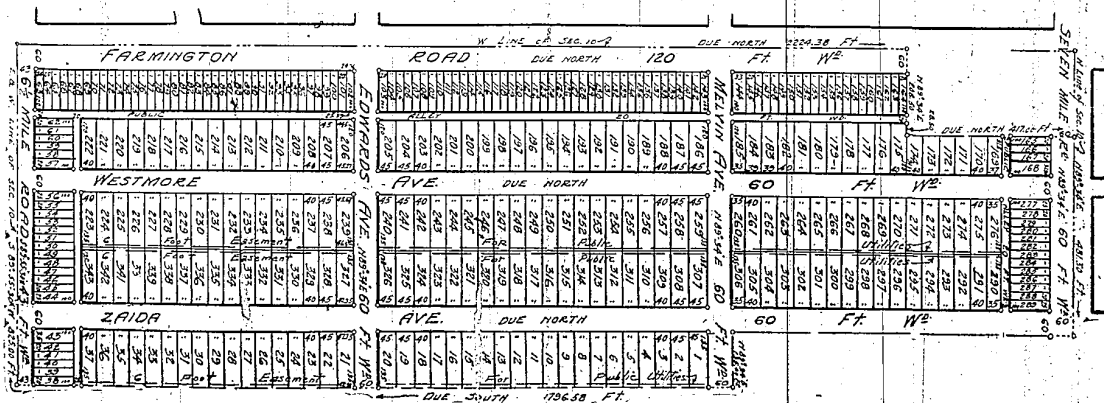
