I see 4-7 year olds being up surrounded by concrete and covered for the length of a dozen stores by roofing. And then I see them acclaimed as the insects of modern society.


I see people in too much of a hurry to get to the country to plant and care for trees, shrubs, flowers and grass around their homes.
