

Moscow Competitor Opens Schoolcraft Series

Pianist James Tocco is coming directly from Moscow to appear twice in Schoolcraft College's Summer Music Festival.

Tocco took fifth place in the Tchaikovsky Competition held there last month and was the only American to be among the finalists.

This is the competition which brought fame to Van Cliburn.

When Tocco arrives at Schoolcraft, he will turn his attention to Beethoven and Britten, the composers whose works will be featured in this summer's series.

SIX CONCERTS will be presented in all-Millard Taylor, violinist, the Kenneth Jewell Chorale, Edward Kingins, tenor, and David Ireland, violinist, will be heard as guest artists.

Tocco opens the series, appearing in the chamber music concert Wednesday, July 8, and a week later in the Court Orchestra Concert.

Tocco, a native of Detroit,

teaches at the University of Wisconsin, and has appeared in the Young Artists Recital Series and the Jeunesses Musicales de France.

Chamber music concerts will be heard July 8, 10 and 17. All will be in the auditorium of the Liberal Arts Bldg.

The Court Orchestra, composed of 25 to 30 musicians from Schoolcraft's summer music school staff, the Detroit Symphony and the Plymouth Symphony, will be heard succeeding Wednesday evenings, July 15, 22 and 29. These will take place in the open air in the South Court of the Forum Bldg.

CONDUCTOR Wayne Dunlap said that Beethoven's works were chosen for special attention this year because it is the bicentennial of the composer's birth.

Dunlap considers Britten a fourth B, along with Bach and Brahms, and like Beethoven a prolific writer, offering the

groups a wide variety from which to choose.

"There is a feeling I have that their works are similar," says Dunlap. "They seem to be the best of their periods."

Britten, of course, is still living and composing in England. His best known work is his "War Requiem."

Beethoven wrote about the events of his time: a little Brahms, Copland, Milhaud and Vaughan Williams will go along with the two B's. Two original compositions by Schoolcraft composer-in-residence, Robert W. Jones, will be heard too.

Kingins is described as a tenor who is handsome, musical and clever. "In addition to appearing in oratorio and opera, he frequently sings as guest soloist with symphony orchestras. He will be heard July 10. His accompanist is Lawrence LaFare.

VIOLINIST Taylor will highlight the July 22 concert. He heads the Eastman School of Music and is concertmaster and a frequent soloist with the

The Kenneth Jewell Chorale is noted for appearances at the Bach at Cranbrook Festival and with the Detroit Symphony. This virtuoso ensemble of 40 highly-trained artists, will be heard July 29.

Visits Ireland will be heard on the same program. He is a member of the summer music festival staff of the Detroit Symphony. He is a graduate of the University of Michigan School of Music.

The Schoolcraft faculty includes Emily Matter Aldrin, Inez Hillinger Rodman, Marilene, Marie DiFiore, Marian Wingett, Roy Ernst, David Marotti, Oliver Green, James Tamblain, Donald Morlock, Allen Shafer, and Jones.

Tickets may be purchased at the door the night of each concert. Admission to the chamber concerts is \$1.50 and to the orchestra concerts \$2.
