MOONLIGHT SKI TOUR — Looking for something new and different to do, here it is. Cross-country ski beautiful Glen Oaks Golf Course by moonlight 7-10 p.m. Friday, Jan. 20. No extra fee will be charged for this special event. A snack bar and ski rental will be available with ski rental fee of \$6 per person. No preregistration is necessary.

DOWNHILL SKIING — Registration is being accepted at the Parks & Recreation office for all elementary, middle and high school students. The second-session, teen ski bus is scheduled for

Tuesdays, Jan. 24, 31 and Feb. 7 and the elementary bus is scheduled for Fridays, Feb. 27 and Feb. 3 and 10. The ski buses will depart from various pick-up points at 4:30 p.m. and return approximately 10:15 p.m. The fee is \$35 per participant and includes tow ticket, lesson and transportation. Ski rental is additional. Register early, space is limited.

KAYAK LESSONS — A six-week instructional course covering basic boat handling skills including paddle strokes, gate practice and Eskimo rolls will be 7-8:30 p.m. beginning Jan. 23 at the OCC Orchard Ridge Campus II Building. Fee is \$28 plus \$18 kayak rental. Registration must be done in person at the Parks & Recreation office.

RACE — A competitive cross-country ski race will be held Sunday, Jan. 29, at Glen Oaks Golf Course, 30550 13 Mile for novice, intermediate and expert men, women, boys and girls skiers. Divisions are arranged with awards to the first three finalists. Experts will race at 11 a.m. with intermediate and novice skiers at 2 p.m. Preregistration is \$4 per participant, \$8 the day of the race.

CPR — A nine-hour comprehensive CPR class will be Feb. 7, 9 and 14. The class will meet for three sessions at Dunckel Middle School 7-10 p.m. You must preregister at the Parks & Recreation Office. The \$5 fee includes CPR book and related materials.
