



Cramped quarters plague officers

While the Farmington Hills City Council continues to discuss plans for a new building to house its police department, the 100-plus officers and civilians continue to labor in the cramped 7,500-square-foot quarters in the city hall at 11 Mile and Orchard Lake roads.

The city's growth in population and the corresponding expansion of the police department have pushed the department to the walls, Claif John Ni-chois said. 


