College offers help to deaf

As a public service to hearing-impaired individuals in the tri-county area, Oakland Community College now operates three telecommunication devices for the deaf (TDD's). The telephone devices which work like teletypewriters can be utilized by those with compatible systems. The caller dials the special TDD number, places the receiver on a machine that resembles a typewriter, and types out a message.

The message is then transmitted through the machine and printed out at the receiving end. The caller and respondent must take turns until communication is complete.
