Douglas Bianchi is conductor of the young musicians, 70 members strong. Bianchi is the instrumental and vocal music at L'Anse Creuse High School-North.

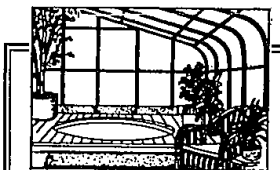
The travelogue, sponsored by the Farmington Hills and North Farmington Kiwanis, is the major fund-raiser for the organizations. It is its 36th year of existence.

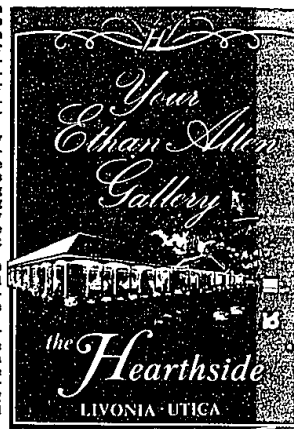
Career options for teachers in class
