

# Contests, programs planned for youth during Library Week

"National Library Week," April 8-14, is celebrated with special programs and contests sponsored by the Friends of the Farmington Community Library.

Children of all ages are invited to enter the "Bookmark Contest" by designing an original bookmark telling why they enjoy the Farmington Community Library, books or reading. Paperback book certificates will be awarded for winners in each age category. Each winning bookmark will be printed on colorful paper and distributed to both Farmington and Farmington Hills Branches, beginning in May.

Deadline for entry is Tuesday, April 10.

Entries are to be made on white paper only. Designs are to be made with black or red pens or markers. The bookmark must be 2 1/4 inches wide and 11 inches long.

Name, age, city and phone number is to be written on the back of the bookmark.

Winners will be announced Saturday, April 14, during each of two puppet shows coming to the Farmington Branch Library, State and Liberty streets.

ation Puppeteers will be performing "Jack and the Beanstalk" and "Grashopper and the Ant" at 2 p.m. and again at 3:30 p.m.

There is no charge for the shows, but registration is requested by calling the library, 474-7777.

FRIENDS OF Farmington Community Library have declared the months of April and May "Use Your Library Card and Read Month."

Children in both Farmington and Farmington Hills are eligible to have their own library card when they are able to print their first name.

The Friends, in cooperation with the staff of both libraries, will be encouraging youngsters to have a card in their own name during these months, along with encouraging all youth to use their card more often by sponsoring a drawing.

Each time the card is used the cardholder has one more chance of getting a prize, and participants can enter as many times as they wish through the end of May.

Prizes are gift certificates, 18 in all, ranging from \$2 to \$20, redeemable at local bookstores. Prize winners will be notified June 1.
