To compensate for the losses, some suppliers also have agreed to move up delivery dates of equipment already ordered, he said.

"We haven't had problems in the last couple of years," said Geiger. "But this could happen any weekend."

The Farmington School District is without its own security force.

THE BUILDING was burglarized twice this past weekend. The first burglary was discovered on Saturday, according to school officials.

The burglars concentrated on the

building's third floor where the main office and classrooms are located. The second floor, where the shops are located was left alone. Only the pop machine on the first level was damaged.

Besides taking the equipment, the thieves broke into a safe containing approximately \$25 and sprayed the contents of a fire extinguisher down one hallway. Other damage included broken classroom door windows and locks.

Entry was gained through a window next to the main entrance which was completely removed.

Because of the number and size of the items, school officials believe that a van or truck was used to haul away the stolen equipment.
