#### Moving day GOP packs bags for township

After two decades in Birmingham, Oakland ounty Republicans are moving west to Bloomfield

County Republicans are moving west to Bloomified Township.
Concern over the wrecking ball hitting its vinage headquarters during a busy election year prompted the Republican Committee of Oakiand County to find a new location.
Volunteers are organizing a move April 14 or 18 Trom 325 N. Woodward in Birmlogham to 1877 Orchard Lake Road in Bloomifield Township. One of two almost identical buildings sharing a parting lot, the new headquarters is just west of Telegraph Road on the south side of Orchard Lake Road.
"Our situation was just too uncertain, especially during a campaign year," county chalman Joe Knollenberg said. "We couldn't take that gamble, that risk." The new location also offers more for the money, he added.

SEARCHING FOR a more permanent location, Republicans have checked out 100 locations in the

Republicans have checked out 100 locations in the past five years.

"It's run hot and cold." Knollcoberg said. He has looked at sites all over the county, from Farmington Hills to Waterford, Troy and Royal Ost.

Two years ago, the Republicans moved from 245 S. Woodward when that Birthingham building was tord down and replaced by a new office building and parking garage. There was the option of moving into the new space, but at higher rent.

When Knollenberg recently was re-elected chairman, the hunt stepped up. The Bloomfield Township resident has not been notified that the World War I-era building will be torn down, but he's convinced it will be soon.

"But we haven't heard anymore. They must get linal site plan and design approval," she said.

Birmlogham Mayor Barbara Jeske said she re-grets that the Republicans are leaving the city.

"Like any business or enterprise that leaves the community, wed prefer to have them here. But there are obviously economic reasons, and they do serve the whole county."

BECAUSE SO many party volunteers live in Bir-mingham, Bloomfield and Royal Oak, there was concern about moving from the area. But Knollen-berg belleves longtime volunteers will slick and the move will provide an opportunity to attract more

workers.

"We think the geographic center is moving out from Birmingham. And we're still in southeast Oakland County — which is where most of the people are," he said.

He also likes the fact that the new location is just own the road from the "seat of county govern-ent" in the Oakland County governmental com-ex in Pontiac.

"I think this move will better serve the whole county. I don't think we'll lose on that at all."

AN OPEN HOUSE is planned for early May in the new headquarters, which has five offlices and a machine room, a conference room, reception are and small kitchen.

At \$1,170 at month, the 1,500 square feet will cost more than the similar size Birmingham space. But the new accommodations are just 10 years old and the \$9-a-tool price includes utilities.
